## POLICIES

### Registration Policy

We cannot process any advance registrations without full payment. After the deadline, **September 23, 2026**, you may register and pay onsite. For onsite registration, payment must be made using an organization or personal check, or credit card. **Invoices will NOT be issued. Purchase orders are NOT accepted.** You must be a full member of SRAI at the time of the meeting to receive the meeting member rate.

### Cancellation Policy

Written requests for registration refunds must be postmarked on or before **September 11, 2026**. Cancellations submitted on or before **September 11, 2026** will be refunded less a \$150 meeting cancellation fee, and/or a \$75 workshop cancellation fee per workshop. If you paid membership dues while registering, these will not be refunded; only the actual registration fees will be refunded less the cancellation fee(s). No refunds will be made after **September 11, 2026**. Refunds are not given for no-shows. Registration substitutions from the same institution are accepted; membership substitutions are NOT accepted.
